General Provisions

Better take into account the Cree traditional way of life

Greater integration of Cree concerns

Participation of Crees in the various forest activities operations planning and management processes

Some adaptations

Sites of Interest - 1 % Protection

Sites of Wildlife Interest - 25% Special Management

Maintaining forest cover in the whole of each trapline

Protection of forests adjacent to watercourses and lakes

Development of the road access network

Participation of the Crees in all forest activities. Protection of wildlife habitats (Schedule C-4)

Implementation Mechanism

Joint Working Group Members
Established in each community

- Oversee the implementation provisions
- Make recommendations to the Minister
- Review implementation mechanisms for JWG
- Involvement in different planning process of forest management activities
- Review GFMP within 120 days
- Study Annual Forest Management plans
- Others

- Act as facilitators for consultations between the tallymen and forestry companies
- Elaborate harmonization measures
- Review conflictual uses to find solutions
- Ensure implementation process of forest management activities
- Adopt internal operating rules
- Make recommendations to CQFB and Minister
